Review the Website



- Familiarize yourself with the NC TWC Survey website.
- Review, bookmark and share survey website with educators participants.
- Review the FAQ's page to prepare for any questions participants may have.
- Review and discuss which educators are eligible to participate in the NC TWC Survey.
- Review previous survey data and set goals with your team to increase participation.

FEBRUARY

Build Awareness



TWC Coordinators will receive portal login information in February.

- Print and hang survey poster in a visible area for teachers to view.
- Display incentives poster in a prominent area to encourage teachers to participate.
- Discuss the importance of this survey with teachers and **remind them it is anonymous!**

FEBRUARY 23-27

Print & Share Invitations



- TWC Coordinators will receive an email with Survey Portal login credentials.
- Coordinators will view educator counts and print survey invitations to distribute.
- ***Coordinators may contact Survey Support to update educator counts.**
- Each eligible educator should receive a random survey invitation to participate.

MARCH 2 - 31

Participate in the Survey



- To participate, teachers should click the button on the NCTWCS.org website and enter their invitation code.
- The NC TWC survey takes about 20 minutes to complete.
- Educators will receive instant confirmation that their survey has been submitted.
- Participation rates may be monitored live on the website.
- Schools must have 50% participation to receive data reports.

APRIL - MAY

Analyze Results & Take Action

- Districts will receive school survey results.
- School and district improvement teams will use survey data in plans to address student achievement, classroom instruction, and professional learning.
